## **COVID-19 VACCINES ARE NOW AVAILABLE TO 12-21 YEAR OLDS!**

**Q: WHO MAKES THE DECISION WHETHER I CAN GET THE VACCINE?** 

A: If you are 18 years of age or older, you do!

If you are 12-17, your foster or relative caregiver or STRTP staff can provide consent as long as you agree.

Q: WHAT IF I WANT THE **VACCINE BUT MY CAREGIVER OR PARENT DOES NOT AGREE?** 

A: If your caregiver or parent will not consent to you getting the vaccine contact your CLC attorney.

**Q: HOW MUCH DOES** THE VACCINE COST?

A: The Covid vaccine is free for everyone.

**Q: WHICH VACCINE SHOULD I GET?** 

A: All three vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson) are safe and effective. However, only Pfizer is approved for 12-17 year olds. So be sure to sign up at a Pfizer site if you are under 18.

Q: WHAT DO I NEED TO **BRING WITH ME WHEN** I GET VACCINATED?

A: Proof that you live or work in LA County and photo ID. If you do not have a photo ID contact your CLC attorney.

- Visit VaccinateLACounty.com or you can call 1-833-540-0473 between 8:00 am and 8:30 pm 7 days a week for assistance with appointments.
- Call your doctor to ask about vaccine appointments.
- If you have been to a Hub clinic in the past, you are eligible to receive the vaccine at a County Hospital. Please call 747-210-8000 to make an appointment.
