

# **COVID-19 VACCINES ARE NOW AVAILABLE TO 12-21 YEAR OLDS!**

**Q: WHO MAKES THE DECISION WHETHER I CAN GET THE VACCINE?**

**A: If you are 18 years of age or older, you do!**

If you are 12-17, your foster or relative caregiver or STRTP staff can provide consent as long as you agree.

**Q: WHAT IF I WANT THE VACCINE BUT MY CAREGIVER OR PARENT DOES NOT AGREE?**

**A: If your caregiver or parent will not consent to you getting the vaccine contact your CLC attorney.**

**Q: HOW MUCH DOES THE VACCINE COST?**

**A: The Covid vaccine is free for everyone.**

**Q: WHICH VACCINE SHOULD I GET?**

**A: All three vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson) are safe and effective. However, only Pfizer is approved for 12-17 year olds. So be sure to sign up at a Pfizer site if you are under 18.**

**Q: WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING WITH ME WHEN I GET VACCINATED?**

**A: Proof that you live or work in Sacramento County and photo ID. If you do not have a photo ID contact your CLC attorney.**
